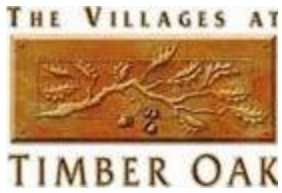

I understand that I cannot proceed without having first received written confirmation from REI on behalf of the Board of Directors. These low voltage lights must be installed in the front or rear mulch area of the unit/walkway. No lights can be placed in the common areas, grass areas, or around trees. All light coming from the light source must be white-no other colors allowed and no dimming lights are allowed. The use of a dusk timer for these lights is suggested. Wires plugged into front outside entry outlet must be covered and no wires are to be attached in any way to wall or siding, they must be placed in the mulch. A choice of approved solar lights or this light can be used. You cannot combine the solar lights with the low voltage lights.
